4/20/2008 2008-0F1-0531 On Sunday April 20, 2008 at approximately 2130 hours this officer was dispatched to a report of a disorderly female aboard inbound Delta Flight #4944 arriving from Philadelphia at gate #9. Troopers Fitzpatrick, Adell and Galvin were also dispatched to assist. Upon arrival I observed a white female approximately 5-3 exiting the aircraft with the assistance of 2 members of the flight crew, who had to hold the female upright due to her unsteadiness. The female was staggering and attempted to break free from those who were assisting her to the bottom of the aircraft stairway. When the subject reached the ground Trooper Adell and I took hold of her arms to assist her into the terminal building. She began flailing her arms and stated "leave me alone, do you know who the [REDACTED] I am ? I'll have a news crew down here in minutes and you will lose your [REDACTED] jobs you [REDACTED]" I detected a very strong odor of a alcoholic beverage from her breath as she spoke. We continued into the terminal building and asked the female to have a seat and requested her identification, she refused. Again she became verbally abusive, she called me an [REDACTED] and stated" I'm a bigshot in Boston and I'll have your [REDACTED] jobs, you think your a [REDACTED] tough guy, you just watch and see what the [REDACTED] happens to you when I get the [REDACTED] out of here." Her behavior and vulgar language caused other passengers and airline workers to stop and stare. I again asked for identification and she refused. I attempted to retrieve her ID from her pocketbook when she began screaming, and swinging her arms, striking me at least once in the chest, breaking my prescription eye glasses which were in my shirt pocket. At this time I advised her that she was under arrest for disorderly conduct. As I attempted to handcuff her, she again refused to cooperate and again started swinging. Myself, Tprs. Galvin and Fitzpatrick restrained her until she was properly handcuffed. She was transported to Station F by Sector R, Tpr. Galvin and advised of her rights by Tpr. Hodgdon.

Subject was identified at the station as Randi Goldklank DOB [REDACTED]. She was additionally charged with resisting arrest.

At approximately 2235 hours Sgt. Luce entered the booking room and attempted to assist in booking the Defendant. The defendant immediately began to yell and swear at Sgt. Luce while refusing to answer any booking questions. Sgt. Luce attempted to explain the booking process several times then advised me that he had formed the opinion that due to the alcohol effects and the defendants drunkenness that the booking process should be suspended pending her sobriety. The defendant overheard the conversation and stated that she was not drunk and wanted to be released immediately. Sgt. Luce then informed the defendant that after completing the booking process the bail commissioner would be contacted for bail. The defendant was also informed that unless someone appeared to take her into custody at the time of bail that she would remain in custody as an intoxicated person. Sgt. Luce also explained the defendants right to a breath test and the defendant immediately refused to cooperate and again began to swear and yell at Sgt. Luce. The defendants demeanor changed and she became quiet, after a few minutes she leaned towards Sgt. Luce and stated " You think im cute and I think your cute, just drive me home". Sgt. Luce then concluded the booking and the defendant was told that she would be placed in a cell pending sobriety / bail. The defendant then refused to cooperate and Sgt. Luce took hold of her right wrist and led her to cell B. The defendant was placed in cell B and she continued to scream obscenities at all officers, she also stated to Sgt. Luce that "My station is going to put you on TV and ruin your life" Because of her erratic behavior and level of intoxication, Boston Health and Hospital was notified and responded to the station to check her well being. Sgt. Luce overheard the defendant tell the EMT's that she had consumed "about three dozen drinks earlier" [REDACTED]
